

The Friends of Beatley Central Library is a nonprofit organization that raises funds to advance the mission of the library. The Friends organization advocates the mission and requirements of the library and promotes public awareness of the library's programs and services. Volunteer activity resumed August 2021when book and media donations were again accepted.

Donations were so generous that the Friends held four mini "flash sales" later in the year. The volume of children's books donated permitted them to be given to Toys for Tots, schools, and community centers throughout Alexandria. Large book sales (if COVID guidance permits) will resume in 2022.

In their advocacy role, Friends make presentations to the City Council and conduct letter-writing campaigns for budget support, as well as maintaining close cooperation with the Library Board. As of December 31, 2021, the Friends had 59 Annual members and 16 Lifetime members. 

### 2021 Income Sources


